Thanks to the above members who replied to my letter of October 1988. Bill and I have reviewed them and are in agreement as to course of action.

The comments were good, and I think reflect the desires of the active membership. Some expressed their backing of Colorado Radio Collectors and all a reluctance to see RMAWA disbanded. I must add my name to this, but realize practicality.

RMAWA is now formally disbanded. However, others may want to reconstruct it, and there would be no opposition to this. There just does not appear to be a nucleus of strength sufficient to continue it within the framework of the constitution as written at its inception. With CRC now active, under a less formal set of guidelines, I would hope that we are in agreement to support this new organization, and through it and other activities, to stay in contact with each other.


One final item of business. The aim of RMAWA was always to promote antique wireless, and possibly to start our own museum in this area to preserve and protect equipment otherwise destined for the scrap heap. The best we can do at this point is to help other organizations with this aim. Accordingly, all the remaining assets of the club will be donated to the AWA in Holcolm, New York, as announced to all the membership we could find in October. There were no disagreements.

The National SW3 that we have in the club is to be sold and this amount and any remaining cash will be sent to AWA when everything is final. Doug Furney submitted the highest bid of \$80.00 and arrangements to transfer this equipment are now being made.
